

WORKSHOP! LGBTQ+ Through the Arts

These workshops will explore topics within LGBTQ+ issues such as terminology, gender identity, intersectionality, discrimination, and queer liberation movements, and will utilize experiential and discussion-based learning methods such as Theatre of the Oppressed, storytelling, creative writing, and devised theatre techniques to dismantle myths, increase sense of identity, and foster a culture of respect, understanding, and solidarity.
